History of Father's Day

On Mother's Day in 1909 Sonora Smart Dodd heard a sermon honoring mothers and wondered why there was no similar tribute for fathers. Her father was widowed when his wife died during childbirth with their sixth child. Mr. Smart was left to raise the newborn and his other five children by himself on a rural farm in eastern Washington State. It was when Dodd became an adult that she realized the strength and selflessness her father had shown in raising his children as a single parent. With the support of ministers and the YMCA in Spokane, Sonora Smart Dodd launched the first Father's Day celebration at the Spokane YMCA on June 19, 1910.
